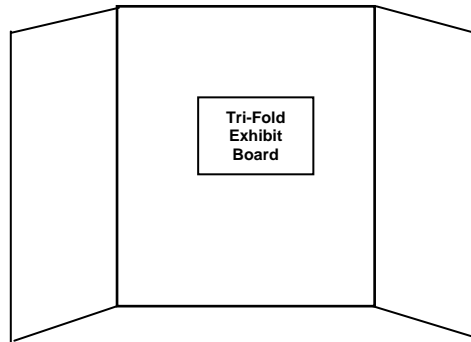
SECTION 1 - TABLETOPS
