A Best in Show will be selected from all Best in Class, Jr., Int. & Sr. . Exhibitor is responsible for feeding and watering of their small animal entry.

Prizes: Best In Class Medallions will be awarded in each category.

Best in Show Trophy & Rosette will be awarded to (1) Jr. (1) Int. (1) Sr..
