

# YOUTH EXHIBITS DEPARTMENT (YE)

## SECTION - 16 4-H FASHION REVUE/CLOTHING SELECTION

Each 4-H member may make only one (1) entry.

Fashion Revue focuses on building clothing construction skills. An entry may consist of an outfit of one or more sewn coordinated pieces. A sewing machine must be used for a majority of the construction. All construction must be done by the exhibitor. Garments must have been sewn since March 1st of the previous year. Entries will be judged for construction, accessory selection and modeling. Contestants will be required to model their outfit during judging and the fair event to complete this contest. Males must wear male garments. Females must wear female garments.

Clothing Selection is a contest designed to encourage youth to use the clothing in their wardrobe to achieve a fashion look that is complementary to their age and body type. A selection entry can consist of an outfit of one or more coordinated pieces. Contestants will be required to tell judges why they have selected the outfit why the accessories were used and their part in achieving the fashion look. Youth will also be required to describe the lines emphasized through their outfit selection and how that has enhanced their appearance. Participants will be required to model their outfits during judging and the fair event to complete this contest. Males must wear male garments. Females must wear female garments.

Each contestant must come to the Extension Office dressed in their garment, ready to be judged on Fashion Revue/Clothing Selection check-in day. Your fashion review garment(s) must be left following the judging with the completed required data sheet attached.

**Prizes:** 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place trophies and rosettes will be given in each class.

A rosette will be given to the best model in each class

A rosette will be given for the best accessorized outfit for the Fashion Revue contests in each class. This will not be awarded for Clothing Selection, as accessories are judged as part of the contest.

1<sup>st</sup> Place Senior Winners in both Fashion Revue & Clothing Selection will represent Osceola County during the 4-H State Congress in Gainesville at the University of Florida. If they are unable to attend, the second place winner will represent Osceola County. This will also require that they complete the appropriate State 4-H Fashion Revue OR Clothing Selection data forms and a portfolio on clothing. These are due to the Osceola County 4-H office by April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010.

**NOTE:** Data sheet must be obtained from Mary Beth Salisbury or Faye Johnson in the Extension office. One data sheet for Construction and one data sheet for Selection.

Contestants must attend the modeling workshops (see youth calendar) scheduled prior to the fair for the purposes of judging fit and poise, in order to be eligible for top prizes. All entries must be modeled by the contestant during the Osceola County Fair & Livestock Show.

**NOTE:** You must also register on the KVLS YOUTH EXHIBIT entry form that must be turned in on Fair Registration Day, with Department YB - Section 16 marked.
