

YOUTH EXHIBITS DEPARTMENT (YE)

SECTION-3 BAKED GOODS

Open to all Osceola County 4-H, FFA, and FHA members. Entrants will be limited to three (3) classes and (1) entry per class. **Recipe must be completed on the provided form from the 4-H office, 4-H website, or your 4-H Leader, and turned in on Fair Registration Day.** If not complete, **entry will not be accepted.** Recipes will be moved to another class if mis-entered. All baked goods must be brought to the **Thursday** Youth Exhibit check-in from 4-6 pm. Items must be on/in **DISPOSABLE CONTAINERS** and require **NO REFRIGERATION**. Items must be cooked (except candy), must contain flour (except candy), and cannot use raw eggs in recipe or have meringue (all eggs must be cooked or baked into recipe). A new recipe is required each year. For example if you made Grandma's chocolate cookies last year you cannot make them again this year. **NO PRE-PACKAGED OR BOXED PRODUCTS MAY BE ENTERED.**

A Best in Class medallion will be awarded for Jr., Int. & Sr. in each class. Only blue ribbons can receive Best in Class. A Best in Show trophy & rosette will be awarded for (1) Jr. (1) Int. (1) Sr. These awards will be given out on check-out day at the 4-H Awards. Check calendar for time.
