Each Osceola County 4-H, FFA , FHA member may enter three (3) classes, but only one (1) plant per class. Plants must be grown by the exhibitor at least 60 days prior to the fair. All entries must be clean, insect free, disease free, and labeled with common and botanical name. All plants **MUST** be labeled through the extension office ~~before December 5, 2009~~. Master Gardeners are in the Extension Office Monday through Friday, 9 am - 3 pm or by appointment to help identify plants. ~~There will be a special plant labeling day at Fair Registration, December 5, 2009, 8:00 – 2:00 p.m. There will be an optional plant workshop for all exhibitors (to be announced).~~ **Citrus Trees should be entered in the Citrus Tree Contest (Department CTC).**

A Best in Class medallion will be awarded for Jr., Int. & Sr. in each class. Only blue ribbons can receive Best in Class. A Best in Show trophy & rosette will be awarded for (1) Jr. (1) Int. (1) Sr. These awards will be given out on check-out day at the 4H Awards. Check calendar for time.
