GENERAL RULES

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** Exhibitor must be 5, 6, or 7. Exhibitor must be 5 years old by September 1, 2011. Exhibitor must be a current member of Osceola County 4-H.
2. **ENTRIES:** Cloverbuds may enter a total of 7 entries, 1 per class, plus Share the Fun Talent Show. No premium money is paid for the STF Talent Show, they will receive ribbons only.
3. **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** All animals are required to be free of disease, parasites, and mites. If not free they will be disqualified. All animals will be checked at check-in.
4. **ANIMAL ELIGIBILITY:** All small animals must be left in their own cages at the fair.
5. **ANIMAL CARE:** Exhibitors are required to feed and water their own animals, including rabbits, poultry and small animals. They are also required to bring their own feed, and keep their pens and cages clean. If not clean, premiums will be forfeited. *Feeding hours must coincide with fair hours. The Exhibition Hall will not be open except for during fair hours.*
6. **REGISTRATION:** Cloverbud Poultry and Rabbits only need to be brought to registration day if you need help determining the breed and gender of the animal.
7. **CHECK-IN THURSDAY:** All Cloverbud entries will be turned in on check in day from 4-6 pm.
8. **DRESS CODE FOR SMALL ANIMAL SHOW:** Blue or Black jeans, White collared shirt or Club T-shirts tucked in, boots or brogans.
9. **JUDGING:** Exhibitors must be present during the judging of Rabbits, Poultry and Small Animals or prior arrangements made with committee, otherwise no premiums will be paid.
10. **PREMIUMS:** State 4-H regulations prohibit competition of Cloverbuds. Therefore, all Cloverbud entries exhibited will receive a participation ribbon and a \$3.00 premium per entry. All premiums will be mailed to the exhibitors after the fair. Please allow up to 6 weeks.

CLOVERBUD BAKED GOODS CLASSES

Recipe must be completed on the provided form from the 4-H office, 4-H website, or your 4-H Leader, and turned in on Fair Registration Day. If not complete, **entry will not be accepted**. Recipes will be moved to another class if mis-entered. All baked goods must be brought to the **Thursday** Youth Exhibit check-in from 4-6 pm. Items must be on/in **DISPOSABLE CONTAINERS** and require **NO REFRIGERATION**. Items must be cooked (except candy), must contain flour (except candy), and cannot use raw eggs in recipe or have meringue (all eggs must be cooked or baked into recipe). A new recipe is required each year. For example if you made Grandma's chocolate cookies last year you cannot make them again this year. **NO PRE-PACKAGED OR BOXED PRODUCTS MAY BE ENTERED.**

Each Osceola County 4-H Cloverbud may enter 1 photo exhibit. Photo must be taken by EXHIBITOR. Entry may be a print, black and white or color photo made from digital photo. All photos must be mounted on **FOAM CORE MATTING**. Photo cannot be professionally matted. Maximum size for single photo is 8 X 10 including mounting. **NO PHOTOS IN FRAMES WITH GLASS WILL BE ACCEPTED. Attach a Photo Id Tag on back with title of photo, name, age, and club. Must include photo release if people in photo are under age 18.**

CLOVERBUD GAME BOARDS CLASS

1. Each Osceola County 4-H, FFA, FHA Cloverbud member may enter only one (1) board in the appropriate age division.
2. Game boards are open to any bonafide Osceola County 4-H, FFA, and FHA member.
3. Maximum size for game boards will be 15" x 20". Boards may NOT be cut into shapes.
4. Boards larger will not be exhibited unless space allows.
5. Game boards must be designed to run on no larger than a **9-volt battery** and you must supply the battery.
6. Boards may be painted, drawn with pencils or marker or utilize any other craft technique. Fresh materials that will not hold up for the duration of the Fair may not be used.
7. Each board must contain only one game and not be part of a series of boards.
8. Boards may be 3 dimensional, however, they must not have sharp objects sticking out, or pieces attached that may be removed or fall off. Chairpersons have a final say over safety.
9. If constructed of brown cardboard, the front of the game board must be covered with poster board, wallpaper, contact paper or other similar material.
10. All game boards must meet the following criteria.
 - a. Made from cardboard, foam core or coroplast.
 - b. All electric joints soldered or taped to back of board.
 - c. Uses simple or advanced wiring (circuits).
 - d. **You must use brads to secure your wiring. Back of game board wiring must be neatly secured..**
 - e. Board must have **covered light** a buzzer or other advanced electric technology such as LED's, selector switches, etc. If LED lights are used, they must be flat on back of board.
 - f. Must have 4-H clover symbol
 - g. Contest entries must have a "Game board Project Entry Tag" attached to the back of the board. Participants should complete their own entry tags. Tags are available on registration day or from the 4-H Office.

SECTION 3 - 4-H SHARE THE FUN - CLOVERBUD TALENT SHOW

All 4-H Cloverbuds may participate in the Share The Fun - Cloverbud Talent Show. You will receive a medal for participation. **No premium will be paid for participation.** 4-H S-T-F entrants may present acts as individuals or groups (groups are limited to 5 members*). You may compete in one (1) act. (One (1) Individual or One (1) Group. The time range for each act is three (3) to five (5) minutes. S-T-F participants will be performing at the Fair. Please note that you will be required to provide all the necessary instruments (including securing a piano) and materials needed during your act. It will not be the job of the 4-H Agent or the Fair to secure or move any equipment or provide adequate space for dance routines.

NOTE: You must complete a data sheet that is available from the 4-H office, the 4-H website or at fair registration day. This form must be turned to the Extension Services (4-H office) no later than January 20th. **NO EXCEPTIONS** or act will be disqualified. Data Sheet must also include words/lyrics for songs, dramatic readings, monologues, poems, or skits. The Data Sheet must include description of act. **Complete a data sheet for each member of a group act listing all members and each member of the act must indicate the category and class on their Youth Exhibit Registration form**

CLOVERBUD CITRICULTURE (CITRUS TREE)

1. Cloverbuds must be a current Osceola County 4-H member.
2. Cloverbud members may enter one tree issued to them in March of the prior year.
3. Replacement trees may only be obtained in the thirty days following the original issuing of trees, and only as long as trees from the original lot are still available.
4. All trees must be planted and grown in the original container issued to them. It must have the original tag on the tree when checked in at the fair.
5. These trees must be turned in on the same day as all other Citrus Trees and will be exhibited in the Citrus Tree area in the tent.
6. Exhibitors are responsible for the care of their tree during the fair.
7. Cloverbuds are permitted to participate in the skill-a-thon.
